So, we are running a Civic Awareness Competition. There will be 3 entry groups...

- 1** Key Stage 1 and 2 Under 11yrs
- 2** Key Stage 3 11-14yrs
- 3** Key Stage 4 and 5 14-18 yrs

Find an image of the town or village where you live that tells you something about its history and/or buildings. It can be an old or a more modern building/ a street view/ a farm or military building, or an object ... just about anything that makes you pleased to live where you do!

Look UP and DOWN!

Above is an example of the kind of image that you might send... but, it can be of anything where you live, however BIG or small.

- **Take a still photograph of it.** Using a mobile phone is fine or even a digital camera. If this is difficult, see if you can borrow a phone to take the image.
- **Write a short description of the image** (no more than 50 words). For example... Where is it? What is it? What does it tell you about the place where you live? Why you have chosen it. What is the story behind the image?

- **Send your image and description by email** to richmondcivicsociety@gmail.com

Choose the highest resolution that you can to send it... ask somebody for help if you are not sure.

Whether you send in your image by email from a mobile phone, or digital camera, **write your name; your age group (KS 1 and 2; KS3; KS 4 and 5); and contact information – telephone/email/address/school.**

The closing date for submitting your image is Friday 2nd June 2023.

All entries will be judged and **WINNERS** in each group will be informed before the end of the Summer Term. The winner of each group will receive a cash prize of £50.

We will want to post some of your images onto our website and put the winner(s) into the local newspapers and into the Civic Society Review. To do this, we will be asking for your permission.
